Congratulations Scouts! Rank advancements have been outstanding. We have more Life Scouts than ever before; all are poised to complete their journey to Eagle Scout Rank. Many First Year Scouts have been participating at the meetings and on the monthly trips. This is apparent due to the many Scoutmaster Conferences for rank advancement. Please remember that it is the Scout's responsibility to ask for a Scoutmaster Conference when he has completed all the necessary requirements for any given rank. If there is any question as to the requirements earned, Coby will be happy to consult with you during our weekly meetings.

The Assault on Lake Moultrie was a great success. The weather looked mighty grim as we loaded our equipment in the pouring down tropical gale. The Troop stood strong and as always, with the exception of a couple deserters we forged on to our base camp on Lake Moultrie. Contrary to what most weather reports predicted, the storm passed with only one hard rain during the night. Saturday morning we awoke to a spectacular sun rise. This year we did the run through the lock and down the river to Charleston a little differently than in past years. This year we raced down, had lunch on Crab Bank Island at the mouth of Shem Creek, then raced back to base camp on Lake Moultrie. Fastest boats out of the seven in this grueling competition were 1st Fort, 2nd Russell, and 3rd Oates. All total there were thirty-two people on the trip .
