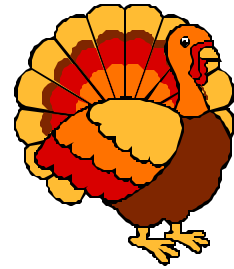

## CATCHING UP ON THE CATCH'EN TRIP

On October 12th, Troop 1 headed off to Charleston for a weekend of deep sea fishing. We were joined by Scouts from 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian's Troop 2. We arrived in the dark at Laurel Hill Plantation and set-up our tents. We soon settled in for a good night's sleep because we had to get up at 5am to get to the dock on time. Our boat, the Gulf-stream, took us out about 65 miles Saturday morning for a day of bottom fishing, which means dropping your line to the bottom of the ocean (about 200 feet) and bringing fish up to the surface with the rods' electric reels. We had beautiful weather and the water was rather calm. We caught many varieties of saltwater fish: vermilion snapper, grouper, rainbow runner and triggerfish were the most common. For bait, we used squid and cigar minnows. Fortunately we only had one person get seasick (from Troop 2).

We returned to Charleston about 6pm, and had our fish cleaned by the crew. The cleaning took a LONG time because we had caught close to 70 fish! When we returned to camp, we had a big fish fry that also included french fries, hamburgers, clam chowder and birthday cake to celebrate Walker Kennedy's 14<sup>th</sup> birthday! It was a great trip, and we enjoyed having Troop 2 with us. Thank you to all of the Dads who went with us.

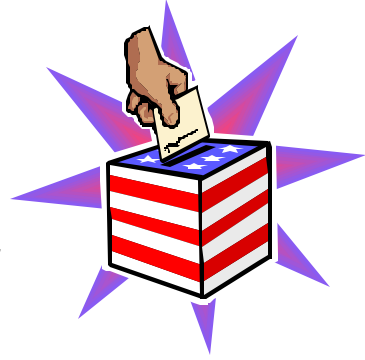
